<u>1st House</u> - Where our rising sign is. Self-identity, appearance, the mask we wear. In the house of 'I am,' Mary displays the identity of the one embracing divine love and spiritual awakening. **The Sacred Feminine Embodied.**

2nd House - Self-esteem, Values, Possessions. From this house of 'I have,' her journey reflects claiming dignity and self-worth beyond societal judgment whilst finding true value in spiritual devotion. **The Worthy One.**

<u>3rd House</u> - Communication, curiosity, early learning, siblings, and manual dexterity. In the 'I think' house Mary is about the passing on the teachings of the Christ. <u>The Wisdom Keeper.</u>

<u>4th House</u> - Ancestors, Family, home, roots, one's inner life. Forced to flee her home; often marginalized and repressed in story and myth, she symbolizes the pursuit of inner sanctuary beyond external affiliations. **The Exiled One.**

<u>5th House</u> - Creativity, romance, royalty, children, fun, pleasure, risk taking. This house is one of the 'I will' kind of energies and is demonstrated by Mary's great presence and unwavering ability to stand at the cross during the crucifixion. <u>The Sacred Queen.</u>

<u>6th House</u> - Wellness/health, service, mentoring, mundane, daily routine, rituals. This house of 'I analyze' symbolizes the sacred devotion needed on a devoted path of purification as well as the organization necessary to support Yeshua's ministry. <u>The Sacred Healer.</u>

<u>7th House</u> - Relationships, partnerships, marriage. In this house of 'I balance' we can see Mary as Yeshua's equal and partner, embodying the theme of harmony. <u>The Sacred Partner.</u>

8th House - Sexuality, death & rebirth, the mysteries of the occult. In the house of 'I desire' we often undergo profound transformations. Here the Magdalene embodies resurrection, mystery, and spiritual initiations. **Initiate of Mysteries.**

<u>9th House</u> - Philosophy, higher learning, publishing, travel. Known for her travels across waters to foreign lands and people gives credence to the energies of the 'I see' house. She was one who hungered for higher knowledge and spiritual explorations. <u>Sacred Pilgrim.</u>

<u>10th House</u> - Calling, reputation, public position. Whilst her story has endured social repression and rejection, in the 'I use' house we can see also a steadfast faith, responsibility, and resilience to greater purposes. Her myths and stories are veiled in doubt, misunderstanding, mystery, and error. Yet she remains a powerful and tall image and icon of sacred feminine wisdom. <u>Tower of the Flock.</u>

<u>11th House</u> - Community, the collective - humanities, visions for the future, friends, social change. In the house of 'I know' Mary represented a break from religious dogma, bringing forth hidden truths, radical new teachings, and challenging the patriarchy. <u>The Revolutionary Mystic.</u>

<u>12th House</u> - Spirituality, the unseen, secrets, surrender, sacrifice, service. In the house of 'I believe' we find Mary's energy being a connection for divine love as she embodies the deepest of faith, devotion, and spiritual transcendence. <u>Mystical Beloved.</u>
